Planon's DocuPen, announced in January 2004, is the world's smallest fully portable, full-page scanner that is the size of pen yet weighs just 1.75 ounces and is only 8.5 inches long. While traditional pen scanners only read individual lines of text and are unable to scan graphics, the DocuPen scans an entire page of text and graphics in just four seconds and stores up to 100 pages in its 2 megabytes of flash memory. The DocuPen meets the need for quick, convenient out-of-office scanning.
